Dear Parents/Guardians,

We ended Term Two with our very first Parent-Teacher Conference (PTC) post-covid, to share the strengths of your child and to chart the journey forward in terms of both character and academic performance. We thank you for the strong support you have shown through your presence at the PTC and we are positive that your partnership with our teachers will allow our students to start the term strong this week!

Semester Two begins with much zest and excitement as we live out what it is to have a strong Team Spirit and a high level of Graciousness through the Back-To-School (BTS) and Gives Back Day activities from 24 June to 26 June 2024. This is a significant move to signal the importance of strengthening social networks amongst peers and the community to develop confident and empathetic communicators in all TG Stars. It also reminds us as a learning community, that our students will need to be equipped with life's lessons through authentic platforms and such experiences will help boost their sense of identity and belonging. Their greater sense of self will inevitably enhance our students' level of engagement in their academic studies. Purposeful learning activities that go beyond the confines of the classroom, will strengthen and deepen learning within the classroom.

As we move into Term 3, we would like to highlight key programmes that would complement one another to develop your child, holistically:

#### 1. P3 SwimSafer (28 June to 23 August 2024)

Swimming is an essential life skill and a core component of the Physical Education (PE) Primary Syllabus. SwimSafer is also the National Water Safety Programme designed to emphasize the importance of safety around aquatic environments. The programme aims to teach swimming proficiency and water survival skills in a fun manner.

The school has organized the SwimSafer programme for all our Primary 3 students. Your child/ward will be brought to either Yio Chu Kang Swimming Complex or Bishan Swimming Complex for his/her swimming lessons every Friday in Term 3. There will be 8 sessions (1.5 hours each). This programme will be conducted during his/her PE lessons. There are 6 progressive levels. Upon successful completion of each stage, an e-certificate will be issued to your child/ward. We seek your kind assistance to help ensure that your child/ward has a proper breakfast on Fridays when swimming lessons are conducted.

### 2. Attendance & Temperature Taking Exercise (3 July 2024)

The ATTEx is conducted twice yearly and aims to maintain schools' preparedness to re-activate the attendance and temperature-taking regime should the need arises and educate students on taking personal responsibility for their own health and practising social responsibility. Please ensure your child brings along his/her oral thermometer for temperature taking.















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### 3. Class Photography (11 July 2024)

The annual class photography session will be conducted on Thursday, 11 July 2024. Students are to be dressed in school uniform (polo tee-shirts and checkered shorts/skorts). Parents will be able to purchase photos from the vendor when the details of the ordering/payment process and photos are ready.

### 4. P5 National Education (NE) Show (13 July 2024)

The NE Show is an exciting and significant event that all P5 students eagerly anticipate as part of their student development journey in primary school. This unique cohort experience allows our students to watch the National Day Parade (NDP) together with their peers and teachers, fostering a sense of unity and patriotism.

The theme for NDP 2024 is "Together, As One United People." This theme encourages Singaporeans to confidently look towards the future while standing in solidarity, emphasizing the importance of building a shared future together.

### 5. P4 Traffic Games (17 and 24 July)

Our P4 students will be brought to the Road Safety Community Park. They will have an educational experience as they learn proper road safety and etiquette as "pedestrians", "cyclists" and "drivers".

#### 6. P6 Preliminary Examination (29 & 30 July, 5 August, 15 to 21 August)


### 7. Parking/Waiting along Ang Mo Kio (AMK) Avenue 8
