Homework Policy

1. Purpose of Homework

- We believe that homework is beneficial to our students as it reinforces learning and deepens understanding of lessons taught, allows students to regularly practise and apply skills and concepts taught and develop good study habits in our students.
- We are mindful about students' overall well-being and want to ensure that they
 have enough time to rest and take part in social/physical activities with their
 families or by themselves.

2. What teachers would do

- Design appropriate and meaningful homework/assignments
- Set realistic deadlines for submission of homework/assignments
- Establish and communicate clear expectations to students on the purpose and procedure of homework/assignments
- Coordinate with other teachers of the class on the frequency and quantity of homework to be given
- Update the whiteboard for homework assignments daily
- Check homework and provide timely feedback to students
- Provide timely intervention and support to students; and
- Engage parents on homework assignment matters and provide them with information pertaining to students' learning progress

3. What students should do

- Refer to the whiteboard in the classroom for homework/assignments daily
- Record the homework assignments in the Student's Handbook
- Ensure that homework assignments are brought home to be completed and not left in school
- Manage time well to ensure completion and on time submission of homework/assignments
- Give his/her best effort in completing homework/assignments

4. What parents can do

- Check the Student Handbook daily to view the homework/assignments for the day
- Provide a conducive environment for studying and completion of homework/assignments
- Supervise and provide support for your child's learning
- Reinforce good study habits and attitudes
- Work in partnership with teachers to support your child's learning and development
- Completion of school homework/assignments should be given priority
